Ingredients (lbs.)	Protein Level		
	16%	18%	20%
Master Mix Pellet	700	850	1000
Scratch Grains	1300	1150	1000

**CAUTION:** Do not use this product to mix feeds higher than 20% Crude Protein. Do not include more than 50% Master Mix Pellets in any ration. This pellet is only intended for the mixing of poultry diets. Do not feed to copper sensitive animals.

For all birds, a source of insoluble grit, i.e. granite grit, should be provided free choice to optimize whole and cracked grain digestion.

For egg-producing females, an additional source of calcium will be required. Offer free-choice oyster shell or large particle limestone in addition to any feed made with Master Mix pellets.

We suggest only using texturized diets with chickens that are over 6 weeks of age when they will be large enough to consume whole and cracked grains.

There is no further need for vitamin or trace mineral supplementation when Master Mix Pellets are used to make a complete diet.
